The Silver and Gold Awards have mechanisms that allow for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL): the amount of required learning for the Silver Award may be adjusted in recognition of learning involved in the gaining of the Bronze Award; and that required for the Gold Award adjusted in recognition of learning involved in the gaining of the Silver Award

The Silver and Gold Awards thus have two possible size values for TCE purposes: one reflecting no RPL; one reflecting the use of RPL.
