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TASC welcomes folio markers and teachers as new users of TRACS

From August 2019, teachers within senior secondary schools and colleges and folio and exam markers will be invited to log into TRACS.

TRACS is the Office of TASC's student management portal found at tracs.tasc.tas.gov.au

The August release within TRACS will extend portal access to teachers of folio courses who need to upload electronic folios, markers delegated to mark folios, and to teachers who will be entering final internal assessment results into TRACS later in the year.

Teachers at government schools will continue to use SARIS to provide final internal assessment results to TASC, but Catholic and independent schools will be able to add this information directly into TRACS.

The new users of TRACS for the latter part of 2019 will be:

- Teachers of folio courses (uploaded electronically) in all schools – from mid-August
- Teachers at Catholic and independent schools – from late August
- Folio Markers – for whom the portal will be open from late September
- Later in the year – external markers (who have expressed an interest) to be aligned with marker scheduling

In all cases, new users of TRACS will be provided just-in-time training and support.

TRACS can be found at tracs.tasc.tas.gov.au which can be accessed once they have received a login. All TRACS users within schools are invited to explore TRACS once they have received this login. Help is available at tracshelp.tasc.tas.gov.au.
