Musical Theatre Level 2 (MUS215120)

TASC, with a focus on honouring the nature and intention of the **The Arts**, also recognises the extraordinary circumstances facing learners and teachers in 2020. Due to these extraordinary circumstances TASC has made the following necessary considerations for 2020 [only].

Recognising that ensemble skills and performance is fundamental if students are to demonstrate their learning in Musical Theatre, the course content remains even though students may not be able to provide evidence of their learning in the traditional means of engagement. These considerations are intended to give teachers maximum flexibility to help students provide evidence of their learning.
