TASC, with a focus on honouring the nature and intention of *The Arts* also recognises the extraordinary circumstances facing learners and teachers in 2020.

Recognising that the production of resolved art works and the development of technical and technological skills are fundamental if students are to demonstrate their learning in *Visual Arts*, the course content remains even though students may not be able to provide evidence of their learning in the traditional means of engagement. These recommended considerations are intended to give teachers maximum flexibility to help students provide evidence of their learning.
