### Community Access Level I (CAC110117)

TASC, with a focus on honouring the nature and intention of the Humanities and Social Sciences Learning Area, also recognises the extraordinary circumstances facing learners and teachers in 2020.

Recognising that some practical engagement with the local community is integral to effective coverage of this course, the course content remains even though 'face to face' engagement with the community may not be advisable. These recommended considerations are intended to give teachers maximum flexibility to help students provide evidence of their learning.
