

TASC advice Humanities and Social Sciences [as of 13 May 2020]

Geography Level 3 (GGY315120)

TASC, with a focus on honouring the nature and intention of the Humanities and Social Sciences Learning Area also recognises the extraordinary circumstances facing learners and teachers in 2020.

Recognising that fieldwork is fundamental if students are to demonstrate their learning in Geography, the course content remains the same even though students may not be able to undertake the minimum nine (9) hours of fieldwork in the traditional manner. Providers are given discretion in relation to the depth studies required in the course. These considerations are intended to give teachers maximum flexibility to help students provide evidence of their learning.

After consultation with the community of teachers of **Humanities and Social Sciences – Geography Level 3 (GGY315120)** the following course content considerations have been made for 2020 [only]:

The bulk of 2020 fieldwork may be delayed until the return to school environment.</p>
