English Literature Level 3 (ENL315114)

TASC, with a focus on honouring the nature and intention of the English courses, also recognises the extraordinary circumstances facing learners and teachers in 2020. Due to these extraordinary circumstances TASC has made the following necessary considerations for 2020 [only].

Recognising that the creation of analytical, imaginative and reflective texts are fundamental if students are to demonstrate their learning in English Literature, the course content remains, while giving providers some discretion in relation to the reflective and imaginative and components of the course.

After consultation with the community of teachers of English – *English Literature Level 3* (ENL315114) the following course content considerations have been made for 2020 [only]:
