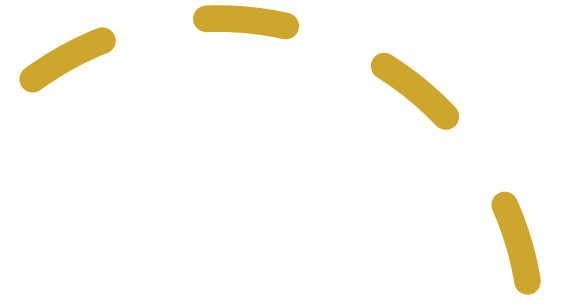

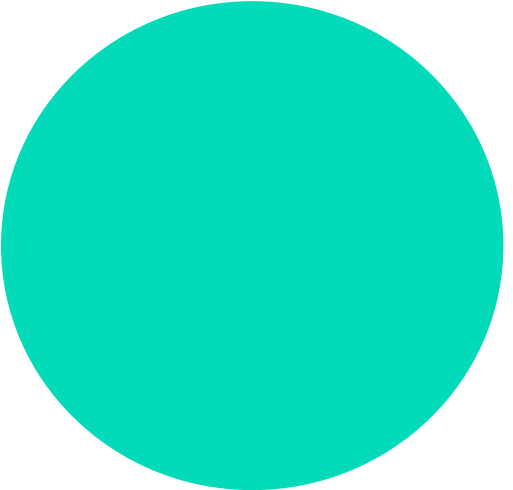

The ATAR is one of the factors used by Australian universities to allocate places to students in Tasmania this year.

To achieve an ATAR in Tasmania, you need to complete at least two years of post-Year 10 study.

1. achieve the TCE
2. achieve an award of Satisfactory Achievement or better in at least four TASC courses or equivalent. At least three of these courses must be in your final year of study.
