Some courses include a folio, practical task, presentation, oral component, or display as part of their external assessment requirements. Students and schools **must** adhere to the submission and marking dates set by TASC.

Students

If your course requires the submission of a folio or supporting documentation, you **must** meet the **internally set due date to your teacher** to ensure your work can be submitted to TASC for marking.

Schools and Teachers

Schools are responsible for setting their own internal due date for students to submit work to teachers. Teachers **must** upload and/or verify their students' submissions in TRACS by the published due date to TASC, for both electronic and non-electronic submissions.

TASC **does not** set or manage internal school submission dates. It is the responsibility of schools to ensure their internal timelines allow sufficient time for teacher verification and submission prior to the TASC due date.
