- Uses a supermarket self-checkout facility with support
- Uses an interactive whiteboard to make choices and selections
- Operates a tablet to access online content and learning platforms

#### **Work Pathways and Transition Activities**

- Identifies personal interests by interacting using technology such as handheld electronic device applications or Eye Gaze, and spending time in Active Learning and exploring new objects
- Uses a switch adaptor to turn on and off an appliance with supervision and assistance
- Identifies personal interests and work-related strengths or skills

#### Citizenship and the Environment

- Greets an unknown community worker through gestures, words or AAC device
- Asks community workers simple questions using AAC device or visual sentence strip
- Recognises signs and symbols within the community
- Completes shopping from a pictorial list and pays for items using a debit card or cash

#### **Personal Development**

- Keeps their environment organised
- Follows a visual timetable
- · Constructs and follows a daily schedule

- Identifies strengths and interests
- Works well with preferred and non-preferred people
- Understands and practices daily self-care and personal hygiene routines with support
