Explanatory Notes

Direct Continuation Reports show data for students in the Year 11 cohort at a school and their subsequent attainment in the next year (typically Year 12). Direct continuation is shown irrespective of where they undertook these studies.

Year 11 students: Students at a school registered with TASC.

Continued to Next Year of Education and Training: A student must achieve at least 1 credit point towards their TCE (or successfully complete a TASC-accredited Preliminary course) in the next year. The study can be at any Tasmanian school, Registered Training Organisation or organisation delivering TASC recognised formal learning. Achieved the TCE: Of the Year 11 students, the number of students who attained the Tasmanian Certificate of Education. Achieved an ATAR: Of the Year 11 students, the number of students who attained an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank. Attained a VET Certificate: Of the Year 11 students, the number of students who attained a Vocational Education and Training Certificate. Values of NR: Not reported for cohorts of 5 of fewer students.
